As a Director on an Indigenous Corporation under the ORIC Act I write to confirm my opposition proposed under this new legislation.

I believe this is a direct infringement on my privacy and I also believe the proposed legislation is clear violation of my human right and Indigenous rights.

It is a clear act of discrimination as these conditions and this new requirement is not required under any other Australian law in regards to Directors of companies and or other legal entities.

To this end I strongly advocate against this introduction to the legislation and believe ORIC should best direct their efforts of regulation and compliance by amending the conflict of interest clause in the this act and be very clear in ensuring all Aboriginal entities registered under this Act are evaluated against "good governance" principles and practices, in particular regulating the conduct of Director's under Fiduciary Duties.
